

STANDING COVID-19 HEALTH SAFETY ORDER

Effective: May 1, 2020 Ordered by: Presiding Judge Kevin R. Madison ©

1. ALL DEFENDANTS, ATTORNEYS, WITNESSES, POLICE PERSONNEL, COURT PERSONNEL, DEFENDANTS, AND PERSONS COMING TO OBSERVE COURT PROCEEDINGS SHALL WEAR A SURGICAL MASK, CLOTH MASK, BANDANA, BALACLAVA, OR OTHER MAKESHIFT CLOTH MASK THAT COVERS THEIR NOSE AND MOUTH WHILE IN THE BUILDING AND COURTROOM.
2. ALL MASKS SHALL BE IN PLACE BEFORE ENTERING THE COURT BUILDING.
3. ALL PERSONS WHO DO NOT HAVE A MASK SHALL NOT ATTEMPT TO ENTER THE COURT BUILDING OR COURTROOM. THEY WILL HAVE THEIR CASE RESET.
4. UPON ENTERING THE JUSTICE BUILDING, COURT PERSONNEL WILL CHECK THE TEMPERATURE OF ALL PERSONS WITH A TOUCHLESS THERMOMETER AND ANY PERSONS WITH A TEMPERATURE OF 99 OR MORE DEGREES WILL HAVE THEIR CASE RESET AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN COURT.
5. ANY PERSON REFUSING TO ALLOW THEIR TEMPERATURE TO BE CHECKED WILL HAVE THEIR CASE RESET AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN COURT.
6. ALL PERSONS WHO HAVE BUSINESS WITH THE COURT MUST CHECK IN WITH THE COURT CLERK AND PROVIDE THEIR CELL PHONE NUMBER THEN WILL BE ASKED TO RETURN TO THEIR CAR OR STAND OUTSIDE WAITING TO BE CALLED TO THE COURTROOM.
7. ALL PERSONS MUST MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 8 FEET SPACING BETWEEN THEMSELVES AND ALL OTHER PERSONS, INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE COURT.
8. NO SMOKING, DIPPING, OR VAPING ANYWHERE ON COURT PROPERTY, INCLUDING THE PARKING LOT.
9. NO MORE THAN 5 DEFENDANTS SHALL BE ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM AT ANY TIME AND SHALL SEAT THEMSELVES WITH A MINIMUM OF 8 FEET OF SPACING BETWEEN THEMSELVES AND ALL OTHER PERSONS.
10. ANY PERSON WHO HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19, WHO HAS THE FLU, FLU LIKE SYMPTOMS, A FEVER, AN ACTIVE COUGH, OR COLD SHALL NOT APPEAR AT COURT AND SHOULD REQUEST A CONTINUANCE OF THEIR COURT APPEARANCE DATE.
11. THIS ORDER SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL AMENDED OR SUSPENDED BY THIS COURT.
