PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY

WHEREAS, due to EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS AND POWER OUTAGES caused by WINTER STORM presents an imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life and property resulting from and other public calamity resulting there from, which requires emergency action; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of BRUCEVILLE-EDDY has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to prevent and to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and,

WHEREAS, the City of BRUCEVILLE-EDDY's Emergency Management Plan should be activated; NOW THEREFORE, I, PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUCEVILLE-EDDY, HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE:

SECTION 1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City of BRUCEVILLE-EDDY.


SECTION 2. That this declaration of local disaster shall be in effect for seven days from this date unless earlier terminated.


SECTION 4. That this declaration shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary and shall be given prompt and general publicity.
