BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

A quote for closed-circuit television (CCTV) inspection of the wastewater collection system is being presented for consideration. The quote presents two options to choose from for inspection of the collection system. There is a Day Rate for 10 hours a day, or there is a one-time cost to inspect the entire collection system. A determination report and video deliverables will be provided as part of the contracted service.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

\$71,817 for inspection of the entire collection system, or \$3,550 per day at 10 hours of work.
